Please **BE PREPARED TO PLAY UNDER THESE RULES.** We will conduct this program similar to the Code of Conduct and Rules established by the IGA/PGA Junior Golf Program.

* **NOTE: PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE** to insure their junior golfers understand and **use golf safety and can play by the rules of golf.** For younger age groups, please insure your junior can keep score. They will have score keeping responsibility. Juniors will have a more enjoyable tournament if they have practiced and played following the rules we have for this tournament.

Junior Golfers need to follow the rules of the tournament and golf course all times.

1. Know and play by the Rules of Golf (know how to keep score.)
2. **DO NOT SWING CLUBS AROUND OTHERS.** Know golf safety and courtesy.
3. Respect the golf course (replace divots, repair greens, and rake sand traps.)
4. Dress appropriately for this event. Neat and clean clothing. Golf shoes with **soft spikes only** or smooth tennis shoes. **Sleeves and collars** on boy's shirts are required. All girls' shirts must be golf attire for women. Mid-length shorts or long pants are proper. No jean shorts or cut-offs. No tee shirts. **Golf attire is expected** by all participants.

The following are **not allowed or accepted** in our tournament.

1. **Parental or spectator advice** to players during the round. Galleries must stay **in the rough, 25 yards** from the player. Parental interference can result in penalties or disqualification for junior golfers. Spectators are encouraged but should not walk close by, or give advice of any kind during play. **This is a tournament for our juniors -- let's keep it that way!**
2. **Cheating and unsportsman-like conduct** can result in immediate disqualification! Poor conduct such as swearing, vulgar language, abusive behavior, club throwing, gambling, or damage to the course will result in penalties or disqualifications.
3. **Slow Play.** Be at least on the tee when the group ahead is on the green. Be ready to play when your time comes. Take no more than 30 seconds to line up, address, and hit the ball. **Move quickly** from the tee to the next green. **A continuous flow of golfers through the course is expected!**
4. **NO TEE SHIRTS, METAL SPIKES OR IMPROPER ATTIRE.** Cutoffs, jean shorts, gym shorts, tank tops, metal spikes and tee shirts are **not allowed.**
5. Caddies or motorized carts are not permitted. Pull carts are allowed.
